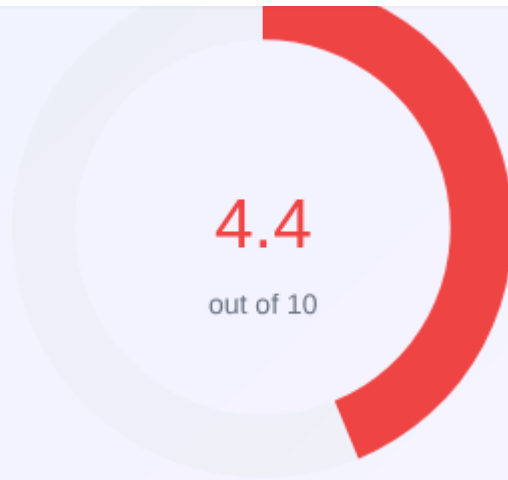

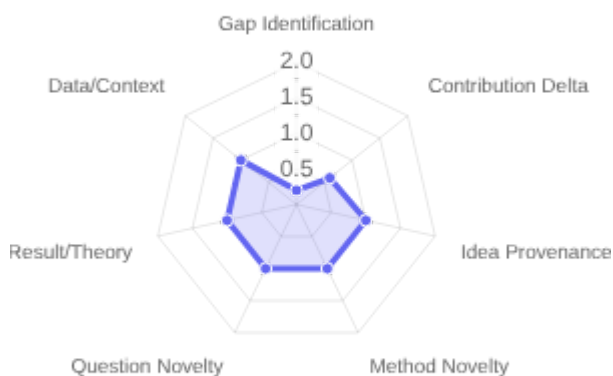

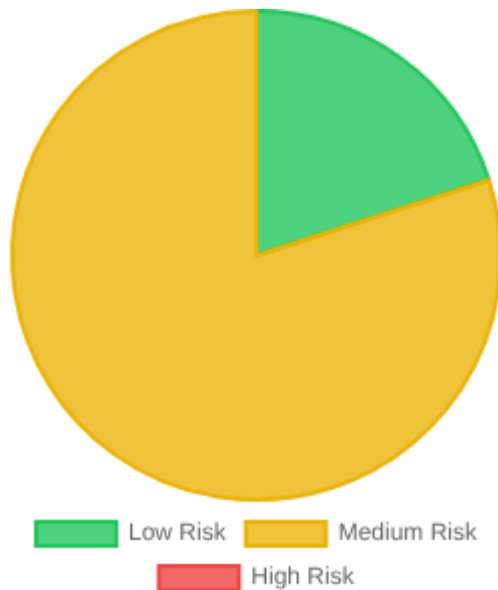
## Novelty Flags
