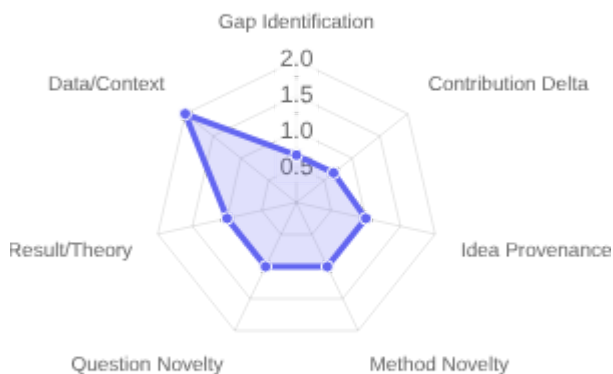

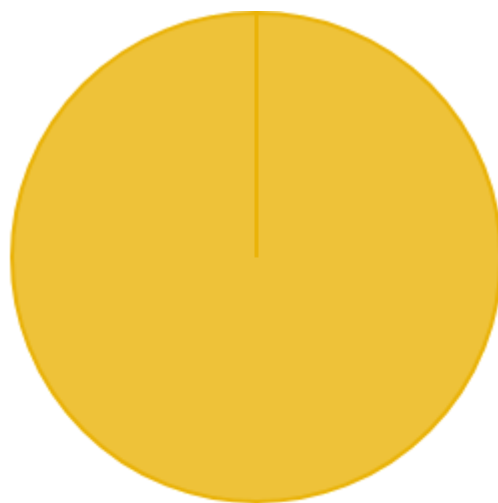
Novelty Flags
